Many People Make Habitat Houses Possible

Most people see Habitat volunteers busy building homes. But before the first hammer is swung, many groups of people spend countless hours getting all of the behind the scenes work completed.

Site Selection:

Responsible for identifying suitable building lot locations for Habitat homes in Northern Saratoga, Warren and Washington Counties.

Family Selection:

Searches for people in need of decent, affordable housing, review applications and interview perspective families.

Community Outreach:

Creates relationships with churches and other like-minded organizations in the communities that we serve to help us increase the number of families we are able to provide affordable, simple, decent housing to.

Partnership Committee

Works with the selected family throughout their home construction, providing a support system and education regarding financial obligations, being a good neighbor and how to maintain a home. Provides workshops for all prior families on career planning, budgeting and other homeowner issues.

Construction committee:

Creates workable housing plans, develops systems and schedules for organizing families and volunteers for construction.

Volunteer outreach:

Responsible for maintaining the volunteer database, volunteer contact and communication, and general office duties.

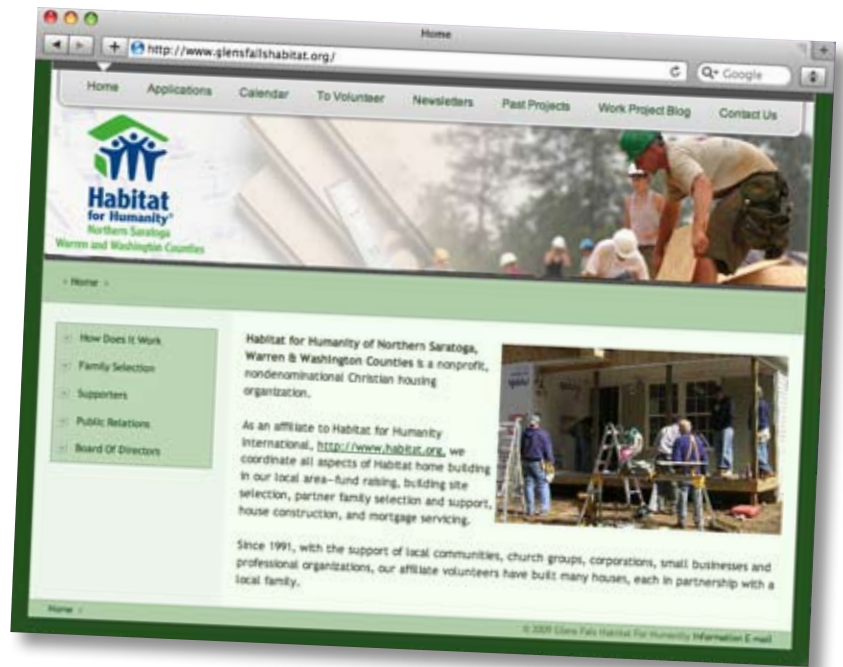
